

## Vegas Nerds Slot Tournament

Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup> 2017

### **Entry:**

Each participant will be responsible for a \$20 entry fee. This entry fee will be collected by Summit leadership at registration. Please bring exact change if you can.

### **Prize Pool (Based on 96 total entries):**

1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$950 (49.4%)

2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$570 (29.7%)

3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$380 (19.8%)

4<sup>th</sup> Place: \$20 (1.1%)

### **Format:**

Registration for Vegas Nerds Slot Tournament will be held at the Golden Gate from 2pm-3pm on Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup> between valet and table games pit. Registration will also be available during the PreakNERDS Sigma Derby Tournament.

Tournament play will begin at 5pm on Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. The slot tournament area is located near the High Limit Table Games pit on the first floor of The D.

There will be 16 machines available for play during any given round.

One player will be seated at each specific machine. A max of 16 players will be participating at any one time. All machines in play will show a player name on the main screen prior to play. Seating locations will be randomized by the system.

Each round will be 2 minutes in length. Players will be responsible for both spinning the reels with one hand and touching a small LCD monitor with

their other hand. Several characters and symbols will appear, each worth varying point totals. Nothing that appears on the touch screen will decrease a player's score. Players are encouraged to touch as many characters and symbols as possible over the 2-minute session.

The availability of characters and symbols will increase as the session comes to a close. The point values for touching these characters and symbols will also increase as the clock winds down.

Each player will be assigned (2) 2 minute rounds at registration. At the conclusion of these 2 rounds for all players involved, the final scores for the first and second rounds will be added together for each player. The players that earn the top 4 cumulative scores will receive a prize envelope from Summit leadership in order of finish.

All decisions made by the Tournament Director are final.

### **Additional Notes:**

Based on 96 players, tournament play will last approximately 75 minutes.

Any participants in the tournament will be allowed to register before the end of the first session (approximately 5:35pm) These players will be placed in an "open" session by tournament staff upon request.

A "leaderboard" will cycle on a large overhead monitor in the tournament area showing the results of each individual round.

In the case of a tie for any of the top 4 spots, there will be an additional 2 minute session that will be held between those involved in the tie. If a tie still exists, a coin will be flipped to determine the higher finisher.

All participants must be members of Club D.
